

## **INSTRUCTIONS FOR HELPING DURING COMMUNION**

When communion is received at the communion rail:

1. Four ushers walk down the center aisle to the first pew of worshipers.
2. Two remain stationed in front of the first pews to direct communicants to the communion rail.
3. Two ushers instruct communicants when to leave the pew to receive communion.
4. Alert pastors to any worshipers who are unable to come to the communion rail. The pastor will take the wine and bread to the communicant in the pew.

When communion is not at the rail, it is offered in stations either by intinction or with individual communion cups. If baskets are used to collect the individual cups, verify that they are on the flower pedestals prior to the start of the service.

1. Two ushers walk down the center aisle to the first pew of worshipers.
2. The two ushers instruct communicants when to leave the pew to receive communion.
3. Alert pastors to any worshipers who are unable to come to the communion rail. The pastor will take the wine and bread to the communicant in the pew.
