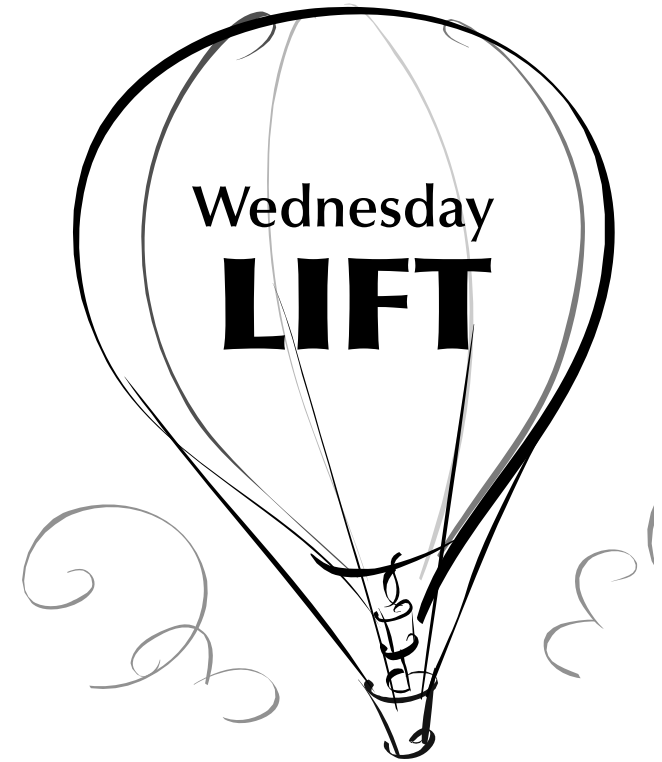
This class, led by Karen Herbrich, provides information on how children can stay safe when they are home alone.
