

# COMMUNION SET UP

## VOLUNTEER RESPONSIBILITIES

### 9:15 SUMMER WORSHIP INSTRUCTIONS

Weather permitting, the 9:15 service is held in City Park. If the service is in the sanctuary, follow the standard communion set up 9:15 instructions found on the bulletin board in the altar guild room.

#### At church/ Before the service:

1. A City Park summer communion set up container is located in the storage cabinet in the Sacristy. The container is a large blue plastic box with the following already inside: 1 stoneware plate, 6 stoneware chalices, plastic covers (to keep bees out of the wine & juice) and Rubbermaid containers for the wine & juice. Remove carefully as the box is a little heavy.
2. Fill the larger Rubbermaid container with 12 oz. of wine and the smaller container with 9 oz. of juice. (You will be transferring to chalices at the park). Place in blue container to transport.
3. Remove bread rounds from small refrigerator. This replaces the traditional communion hosts and pita bread (that was used in past years).
4. Place in blue container and hand carry to park.

#### At park/Before the service:

1. Fill 2 small chalices  $\frac{1}{2}$  full of wine and the other 2 chalices fill  $\frac{1}{3}$  full of juice.
2. Put bee covers on chalices and place on altar.
3. Place 3-4 slices of bread on the stoneware plate and place on altar. A cover is available to place over plate.

#### At park/After the service:

1. Pour all the unused wine and juice into the grass, returning the consecrated wine/juice to the earth.
2. Place materials back into the blue box.

#### At church/After the service:

1. Wash all items in hot, soapy water.
2. Leave the covers off the wine and juice containers so they can air dry.
3. Put blue box back on shelf in sacristy.
