This Sunday is Faith Family Sunday Our Focus is on Communion

During worship, ask younger children to draw pictures of healthy things they like to eat - apples, yogurt, chicken, etc. Ask older children to pay attention as they walk up for their blessing or communion. What is the pastor or communion server saying and when are they saying it? Who is receiving communion? What are people doing after they receive communion?



During dinner some night this week talk about what the younger ones drew and what they like about those foods. Point out that they nourish and strengthen us. Also point out that just as family members come together to eat as one family, we are coming together as the family of Christ during communion. Christ strengthens and nourishes us and we are reminded with the words spoken that these gifts are given as a symbol of Christ's love for us.
