Only your peace can sustain me through the anxiety and stresses of exam nerves. Your peace surpasses all understanding. I ask for this gift and choose to lean upon you.

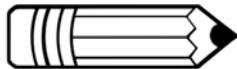
Lord, come and remind me of your unfailing love. Remind me that you hold me safe, you understand me, and you cherish me.

The final day of Sunday School is May 21! Don't forget to thank your teachers for all of their hard and dedicated work this year!

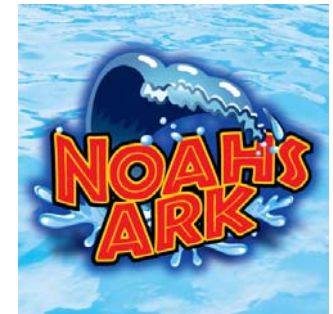


7th & 8th Grade Are Gettin' Cool At The Pool
